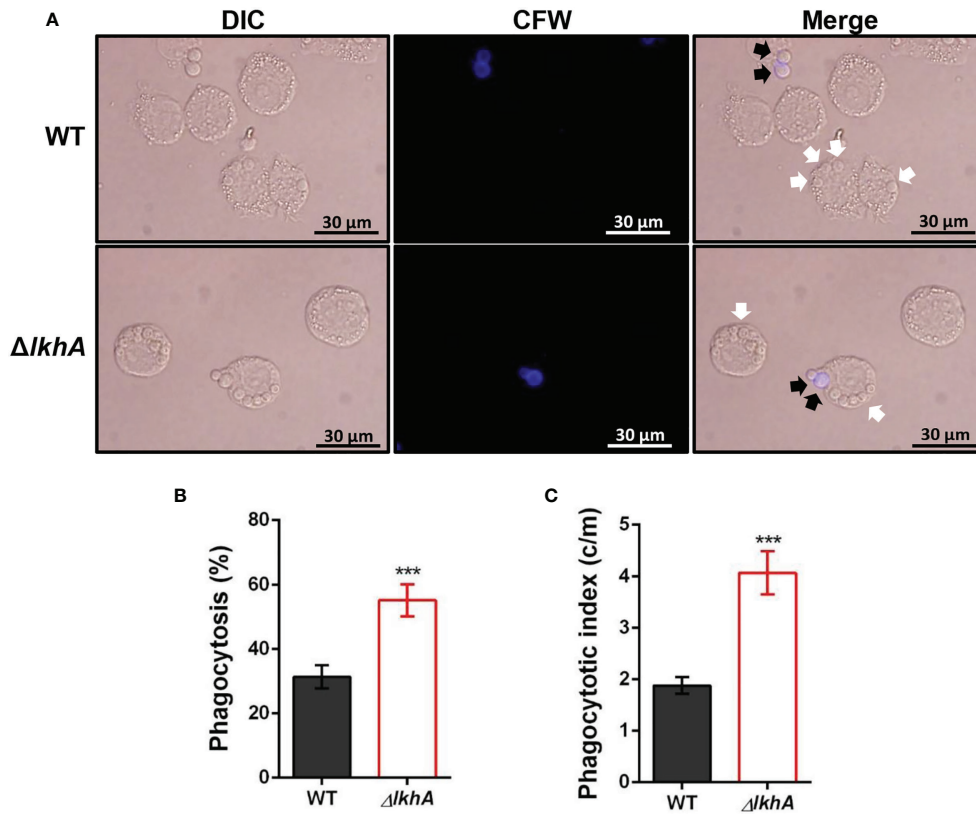

External conidia (black arrows) were stained by calcofluor white (1 mg/mL in DPBS). White arrows indicate conidia endocytosed by macrophage cells. **(B)** Phagocytosis of conidia. The percentage of macrophages containing more than one ingested conidia was counted (n = 18). **(C)** Phagocytosis index. The average number of indigested conidia per macrophage (c/m) was calculated (n = 40). Statistical analysis was performed using the student's t-test. \*\*\*P < 0.001.
