Since publication of our article [1], we have regrettably noticed an error. The molarities of 16, 48, 80 and 112 $\mu\text{g/mL}$ solutions of dNSurR9-C84A of molecular weight 42 kDa were incorrectly given as 1, 3, 5, and 7 μM . The correct molarities which should be used throughout are 0.38, 1.1, 1.9, and 2.7 μM , respectively.

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
