


FIGURE 1 | (A) Survival (%) of phloroglucinol-pretreated brine shrimp larvae after 48 h of challenge with *V. parahaemolyticus* MO904. The larvae were pretreated with phloroglucinol at the indicated doses for 2 h, rinsed to wash away the compound, and then allowed to recover for 2 h. The larvae were subsequently challenged with *V. parahaemolyticus* at 10⁷ cells/ml of rearing water. Non-pretreated larvae that were either challenged with *V. parahaemolyticus* (positive control) or unchallenged (negative control) served as controls. Error bars represent the standard error of five replicates; different letters indicate significant differences (*P* < 0.001).
