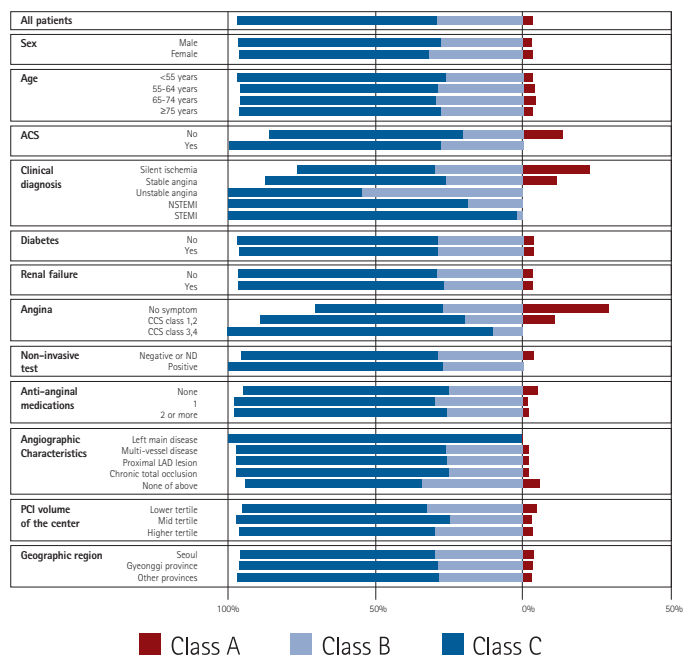

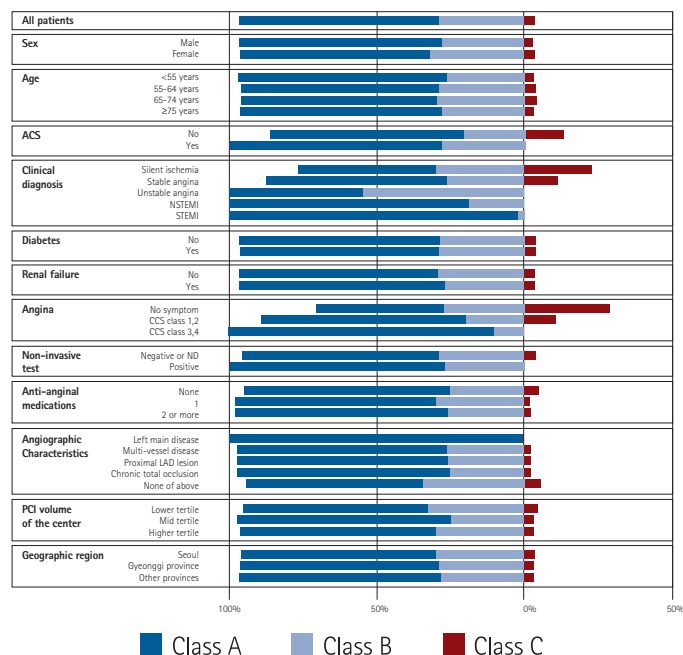


Fig. 1. The proportion of class A, B and C cases according to clinical and angiographic variables.
