Intracerebral haemorrhage: case report

In a prospective, single centre study involving 554 patients admitted to the hospital in Turkey between 16 April 2020 to 14 January 2021, a patient [age and sex not stated] was described, who developed intracerebral haemorrhage following warfarin overdose. The patient, who had COVID-19 infection with acute ischaemic stroke, started receiving warfarin [route and dosage not stated]. Subsequently, the patient developed intracerebral haemorrhage due to warfarin overdose [duration of treatment to reaction onset not stated].
