


Figure 1: Epidemic curve of weekly total COVID-19 cases, deaths, mean number of contacts per case, and timeline of key public health restrictions implemented and relaxed from March to July 2020 in Ireland.

The graphical misalignment, and the tabulated public health restrictions included in the composite Figure 1, have now been corrected online.
