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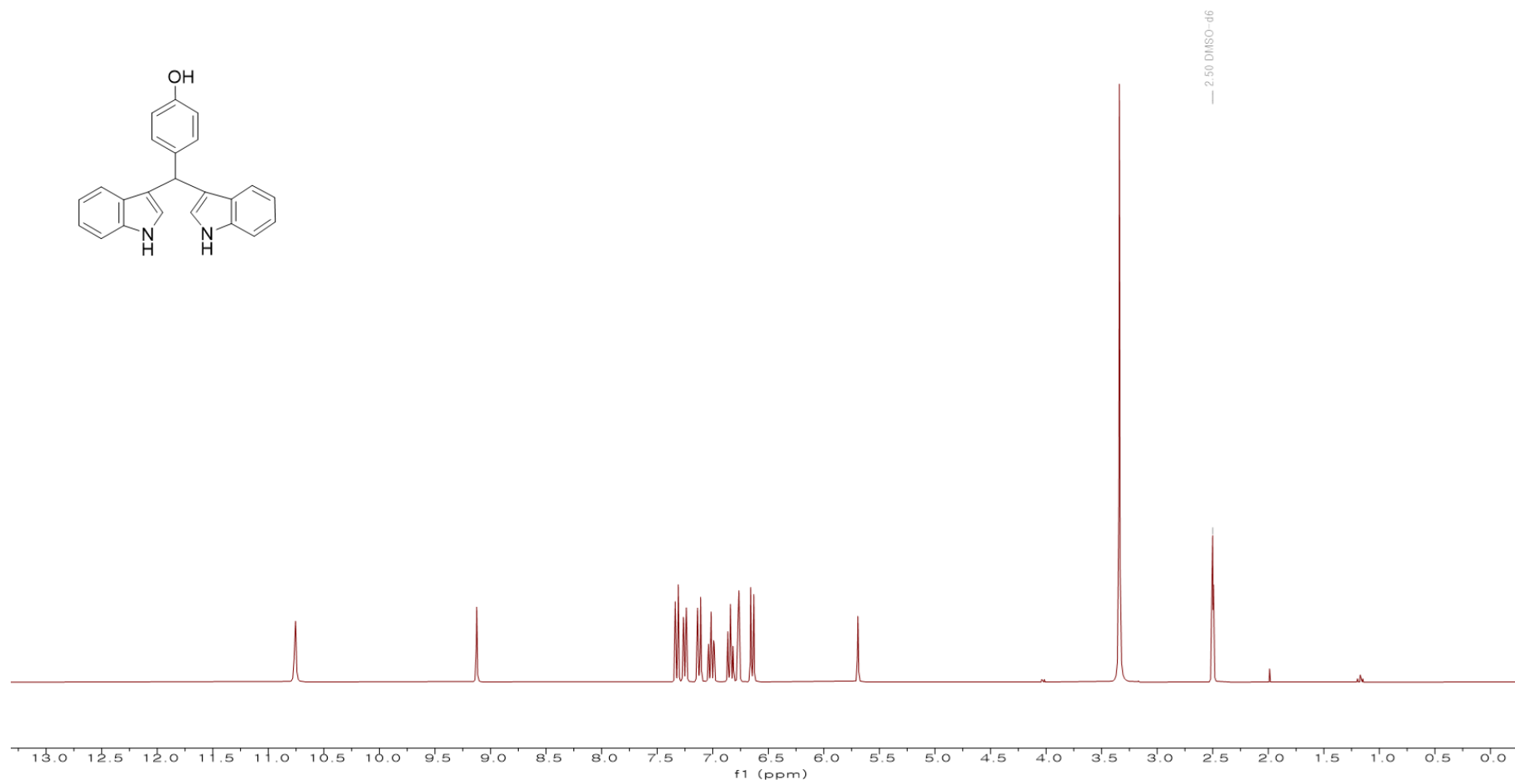


Figure S1. ¹H NMR spectrum of 7,7-Bis(3-indolyl)-*p*-cresol (**1**) in DMSO-*d*₆

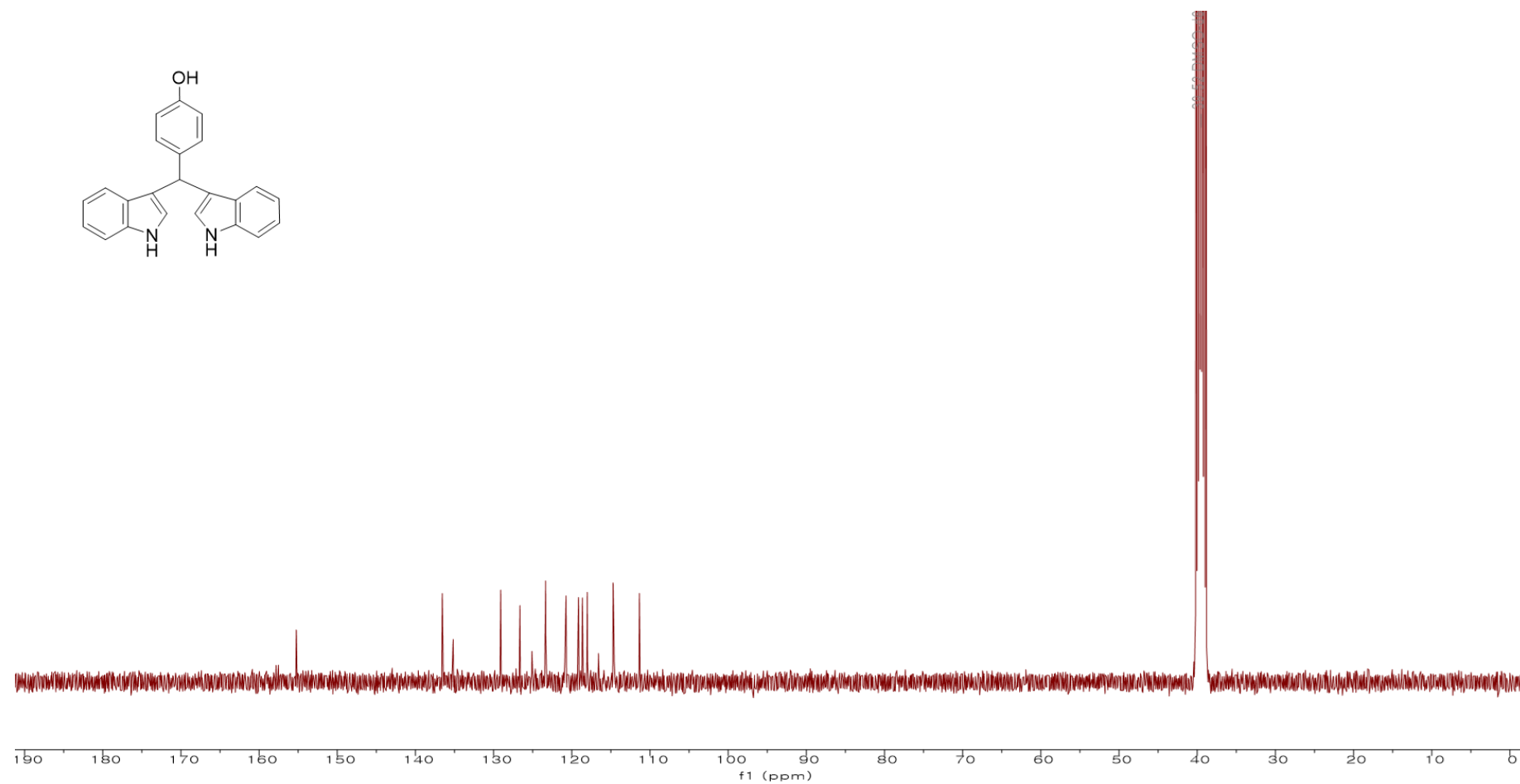
