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Headache, fever and vaccine failure while breast feeding: case report

In a longitudinal cohort study involving 2312 female patients, one woman [*exact age not stated*] was described, who developed headache and fever following tozinameran vaccine. Additionally, she exhibited lack of efficacy following treatment with tozinameran vaccine while breast feeding.

The lactating woman had history of COVID-19 infection. She had received both doses of vaccine administration with tozinameran [mRNA-based SARS-CoV-2 vaccine; BNT162b2; *dosage and routes not stated*] while breastfeeding. She did not show any milk conversion after receiving both doses (lack of efficacy). Subsequently, she experienced headache and fever secondary to tozinameran [*duration of treatment to reactions onset and outcome not stated*].
