University of Rochester

- · Primary Tumor Removed
- Response to Chemotherapy ≥12 months
- No Evidence of Extrahepatic Disease
- CEA <80ng/dL
- Patient ECOG 0 or 1 and age ≤65
- Absence of synergistic tumor mutations (KRAS & TP53)
- Oslo Score ≤ 2

Cleveland Clinic

- > 12 Months From Primary Tumor Removal
- Response to Chemotherapy 6-12months
- No Evidence of Extrahepatic Disease
- CEA <100ng/dL
- Patient ECOG 0 or 1 and age ≤65
- Absence of tumor mutation (BRAF)

University Health Network

- Response to Chemotherapy at least 6 months
- Primary CRC resected > 6 months
- No Evidence of Extrahepatic Disease
- CEA stable or decreasing at all points prior to liver transplant
- Patient ECOG 0 or 1 and age 18-68
- Absence of tumor mutation (BRAF)
