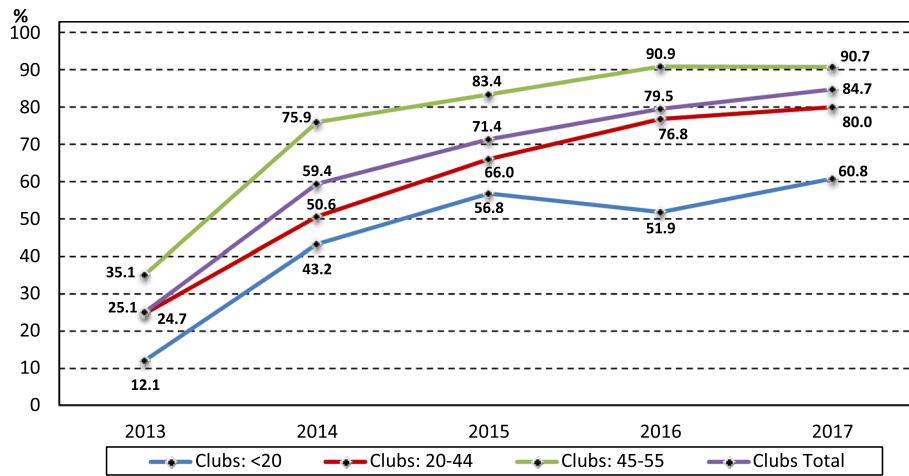


Fig. 3 Percentage of EGMs with note acceptors in NT clubs by club size, 2013 to 2017

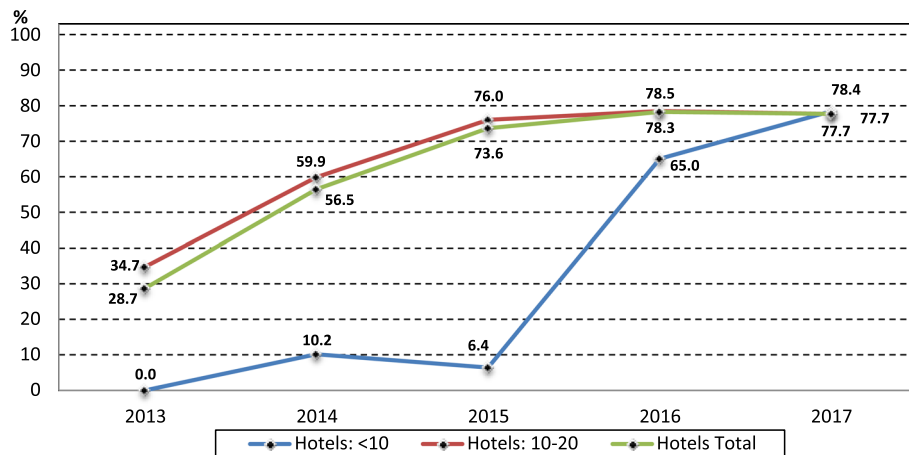


Fig. 4 Percentage of EGMs with note acceptors in NT hotels by hotel size, 2013 to 2017
