Correction: Participation of women and children in hunting activities in Sierra Leone and implications for control of zoonotic infections

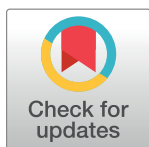

There is an error in the seventh sentence of the Results section. The correct sentence is: Respondents were predominantly Mende (n = 41, 89%), or mixed Mende (n = 4, 9%), or Kono (n = 1, 2%), and either Muslim (n = 18, 39%), Christian (n = 22, 48%) or of unknown religion (n = 6, 13%).
