In a report, a woman and a man [ages not stated] were described, who developed acute generalised exanthematic pustulosis following off label treatment with hydroxychloroquine for COVID-19. The patients were diagnosed with COVID-19. They were hospitalised in Iran, and started receiving off label treatment with hydroxychloroquine [routes and dosages not stated]. Subsequently, they developed acute generalised exanthematic pustulosis due to hydroxychloroquine [duration of treatment to reaction onset not stated, not all outcomes stated].
