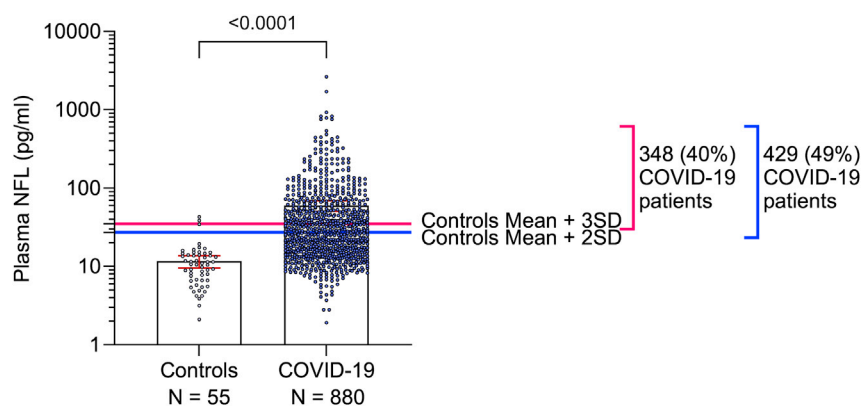


Figure 1. Plasma NFL is elevated in patients with COVID-19 within 5 days of hospitalization
